It can save your life!



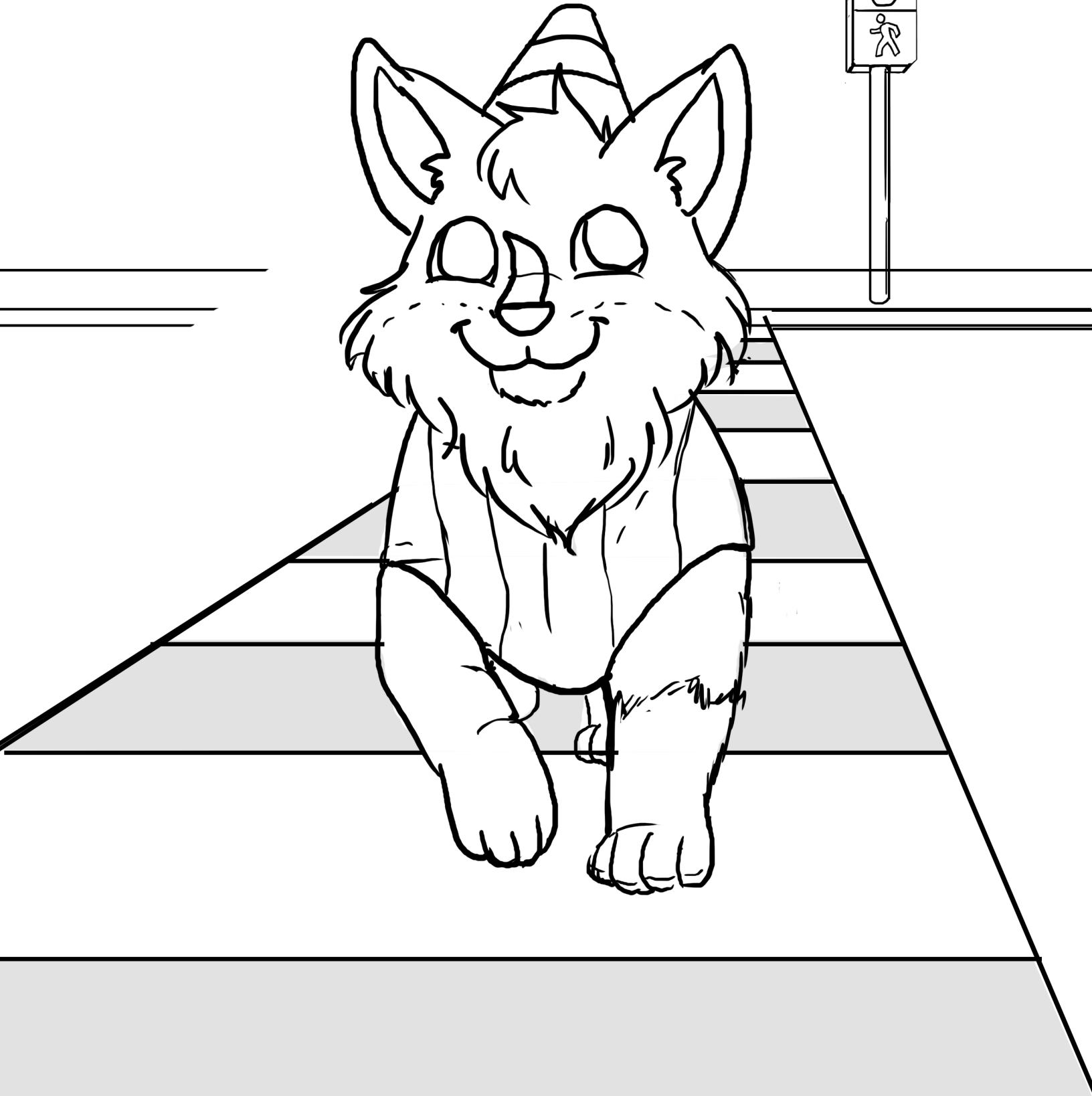
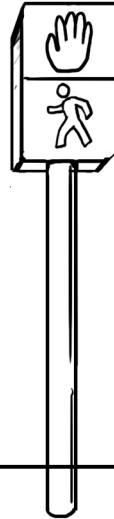


**KDOT keeps Kansas moving!

across our state.**



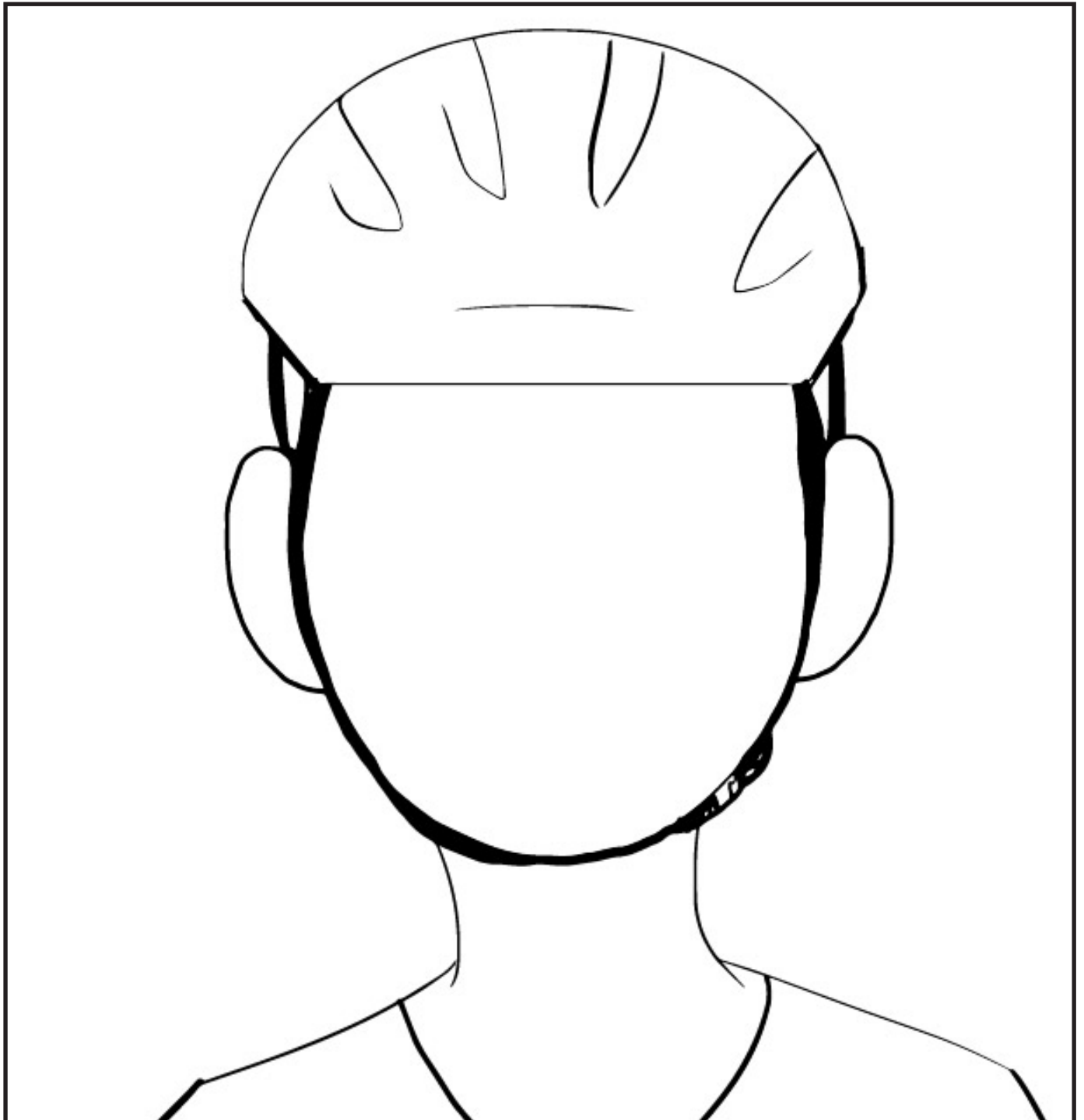
Pay attention when you are walking.
