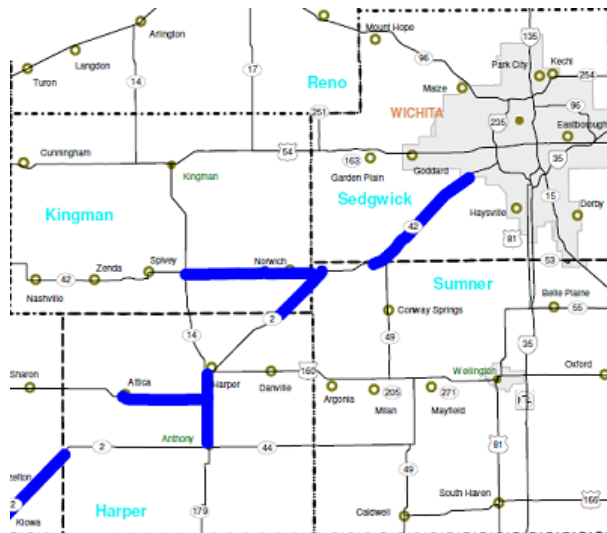

Crews testing pavement strength next week in Harper, Kingman, Sedgwick and Sumner counties



The Kansas Department of Transportation will be testing pavement strength July 23 to July 26 on the above roads in Harper, Kingman, Sedgwick and Sumner counties.

A pilot car operation will be in effect during testing.
