Asphalt overlay detours K-61 connection to US-50 Highway near Pleasantview

As part of a Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) asphalt overlay project on US-50 Highway currently underway west of the City of South Hutchinson near the Pleasantview community, the curved ramp connecting northbound K-61 Highway to eastbound US-50 will be detoured on Thursday, April 23 and Friday, April 24, depending on delays caused by adverse weather conditions. The detoured traffic on northbound K-61 connecting to eastbound US-50 will be controlled by flagmen and pilot car, so drivers can expect delays of up to 15 minutes. The westbound US-50 Highway connection to southbound K-61 Highway will be unaffected by this project.

APAC Kansas, Inc., Shears Division from Hutchinson is the prime contractor for this project, which is funded by T-WORKS, the transportation program passed by the Kansas Legislature in May 2010.
