I-135 pavement marking in Harvey County set to start Oct. 7

Work is expected to begin Friday, Oct. 7, on a pavement-marking project on I-135 in Harvey County.

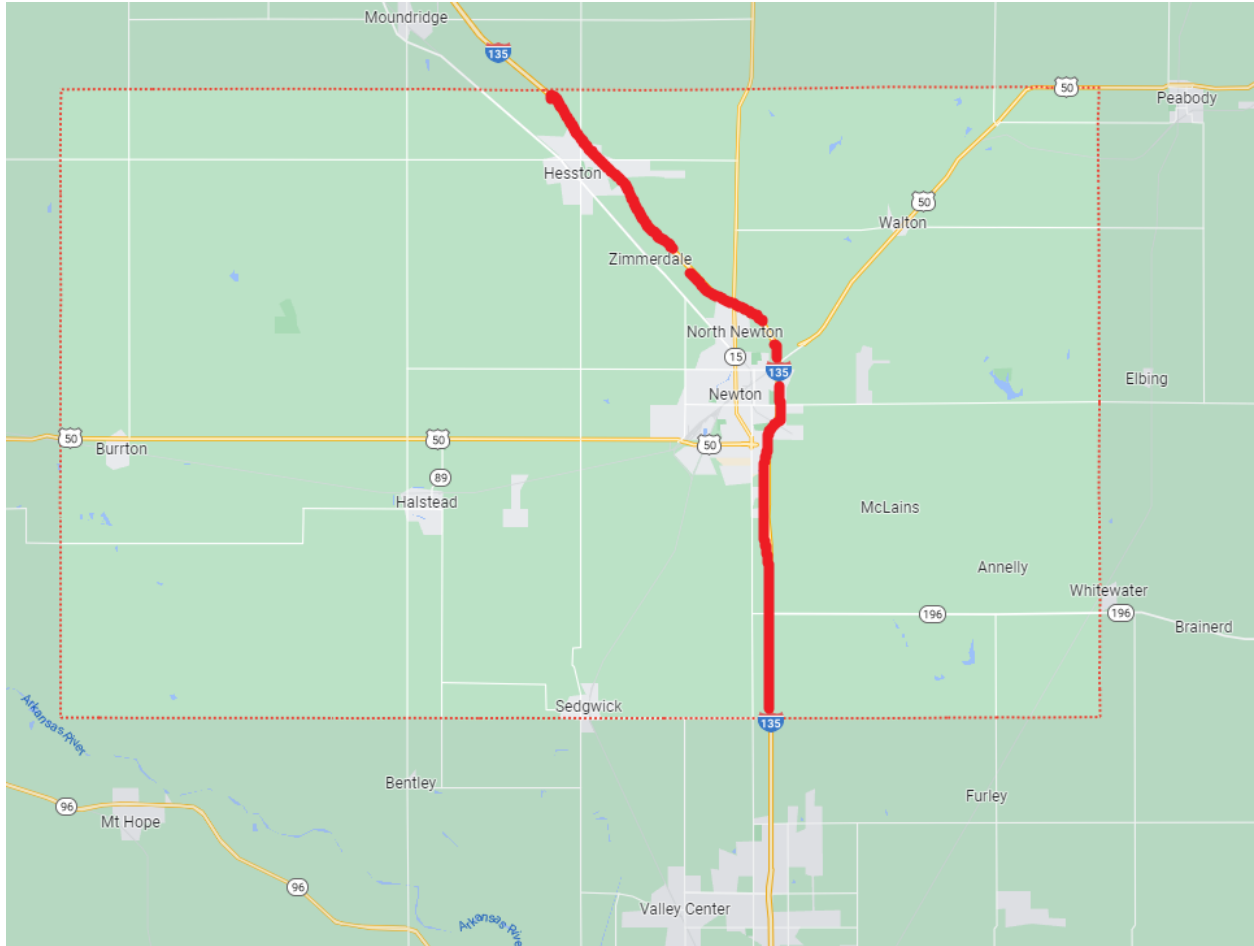
The Kansas Department of Transportation project involves pavement marking on parts of I-135 from the Sedgwick/Harvey county line to the Harvey/McPherson county line. The work is planned to begin at the northern end and proceed south. The length of the project is 21 miles.

During the project, expected to be completed around Nov. 3, traffic will be restricted to one lane in the area where the contractor is working. Motorists will be directed to drive at a reduced speed.

Cillessen & Sons Inc., of Kechi, is the primary contractor for the \$436,371 project.
