KTA project will close U.S. 166 bridge, result in detour

A Kansas Turnpike Authority project on the U.S. 166 bridge over I-35/Kansas Turnpike will soon close U.S. 166 at the bridge and result in a detour.

The bridge closure and detour – **see map below** – is expected to begin March 28, weather permitting. The designated detour for U.S. 166 traffic will be marked with signage starting March 28 through mid-November, weather and schedule permitting.

The detour will use U.S. 160 to the north, U.S. 81 to the west and U.S. 77 to the east.

Intermittent lane closures on I-35/Turnpike near mile marker 4.049 can also be expected throughout the project.

The KTA project will include increasing the bridge's vertical clearance and allowing for rehabilitation work.
