U.S. 81 crack repair in Sumner County to begin soon

A U.S. 81 crack repair project in Sumner County is expected to start around Monday, Feb. 26.

The Kansas Department of Transportation project will be on U.S. 81 from East 60th Street South continuing north to the Sumner/Sedgwick county line -- excluding Wellington. The project length is a little over 30 miles.

The project is expected to be completed around March 22.

During the work, traffic will be restricted to one lane and controlled by flaggers and a pilot car. Motorists should expect to slow down and stop and face a delay of up to 15 minutes.

The map below shows the approximate project length, traced in red.
