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I-35 resurfacing project to start in Coffey County

The week of March 7 the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to start a mill and overlay project on I-35 in Coffey County. The 11.6-mile project area begins at the Lyon-Coffey county line and continues northeast to end south of the U.S. 75 junction.

There will be intermittent lane closures during both day and night hours until the road work is completed in May. The project contractor is Bettis Asphalt & Construction of Topeka, and the cost of construction is \$7 million.
