KDOT repairing concrete on U.S. 400

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) has started a full-depth concrete patching project on U.S. 400 in Montgomery County. Crews are replacing concrete on the four-lane section at the south junction with U.S. 75.

U.S. 400 traffic will be restricted to one lane with a speed limit of 50 miles an hour at the work zones. Weather permitting, the road work should be finished in one month.
