## U.S. 400 railroad crossing repairs at Cherokee next week

The BNSF Railway will close and repair its crossing east of the U.S. 400/K-7 junction at Cherokee next week. The work is expected to begin at 6 a.m. Monday, Oct. 25, and continue through Thursday, Oct. 28.
