## **K-47 in Neosho County to close for railroad crossing repairs**

Tuesday through Friday, April 24-27, the South Kansas & Oklahoma (SKOL) Railroad will close and repair its crossing on K-47 east of U.S. 169. K-47 will be closed to through traffic between U.S. 169 and U.S. 59 until work at the crossing is completed.

The signed detour for K-47 eastbound traffic is as follows: from the U.S. 169/K-47 junction travel south on U.S. 169 to U.S. 400, proceed east on U.S. 400 to U.S. 59 at Parsons, and travel north on U.S. 59 to K-47. Westbound traffic should take the same route in the opposite direction.
