Flagging operation on U.S. 166 through September

Beginning Wednesday, Aug. 31, drivers can expect intermittent delays on a section of U.S. 166 in Cherokee County. A flagging operation will direct one-lane traffic on U.S. 166 between K-26 and the Missouri state line.

Construction vehicles on the current U.S. 166 expansion project will periodically cross the highway. Expect brief delays through September.
