KDOT to replace crossroad pipe on K-33

Tuesday, Oct. 25, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to close a section of K-33 in Franklin County to replace a crossroad pipe. K-33 will be closed from north of Wellsville to the Douglas County line. Traffic should use alternate routes between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.
