## U.S. 59 bridge survey starts next week

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to start a field survey at a bridge on U.S. 59 in Neosho County the week of Sept. 5. The bridge spans Little Canville Creek and is approximately 1 mile south of the U.S. 59/K-39 junction.

The survey area of 3,300 feet is based on the existing highway alignment. Survey crew members will gather information for the detailed design of a future bridge replacement project. KDOT expects the survey to be complete by Oct. 21.

Activities include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor. A member of the survey crew will contact property owners or tenants for permission to enter private property. Michael Lay of GBA will manage the survey for KDOT.
