U.S. 59 resurfacing project set to begin in early August

Late in the week of Aug. 1-5 the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) expects to start a mill and overlay project on U.S. 59 from the Oklahoma-Kansas state line to the north city limits of Oswego.

Flaggers and a pilot car will guide one-lane traffic through the work zone during daylight hours. Expect delays of 15 minutes or less until the project is completed in mid-August.
