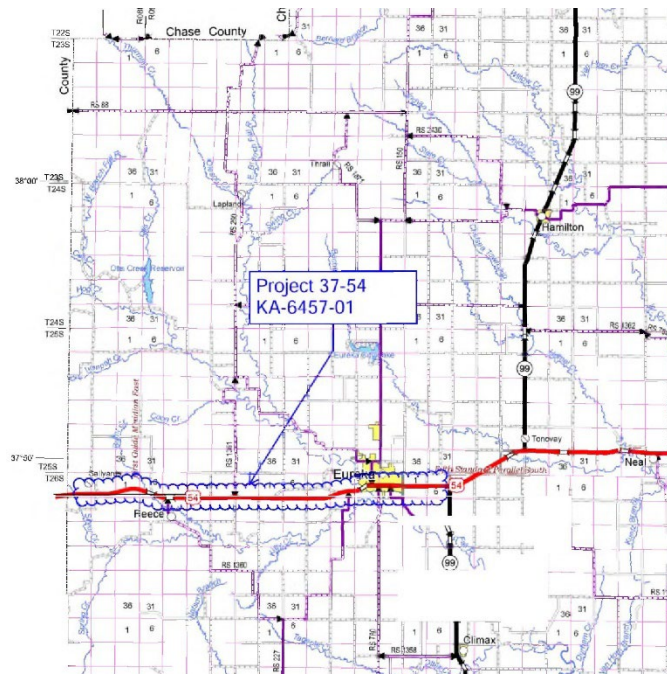

Survey on U.S. 54 starts April 25

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to begin a field survey on Monday, April 25, on U.S. 54 in Greenwood County. The locations being surveyed are along the corridor on the existing highway alignment, located from the Greenwood/Butler county line east to just east of Eureka.

Activities include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor. KDOT expects the guardrail location survey to be completed by May 10. A member of the survey crew will contact property owners or tenants for permission to enter private property.
