KDOT to replace crossroad pipes on U.S. 160

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to close sections of U.S. 160 in Elk County to replace crossroad pipes on Thursday and Friday, Sept. 8-9.

On Sept. 8 the highway will be closed to through traffic from the K-99 junction at Moline west to K-15. The work zone will be located at the west city limits of Moline.

The Sept. 9 closure is from K-99 east to U.S. 75. The work zone will be set up between Oak Valley and the Montgomery County line.

The closures will be in effect from 7 a.m. until 8 p.m. each day. Traffic should use alternate routes. Check KDOT's updated traveler information website, www.Kandrive.org, for more highway condition and construction details.
