KDOT to resume concrete replacement work on U.S. 400 in Greenwood County

Monday, July 25, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will resume work to replace concrete panels on U.S. 400 in Greenwood County. The road work will take place between K-99 and the Greenwood-Wilson county line.

U.S. 400 traffic will be reduced to one lane controlled by temporary signals. Expect brief delays at the work zone. Weather permitting, the road work will be finished by early September.
