## K-33 resurfacing project starts in April

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) expects to start a resurfacing project on K-33 in Franklin and Douglas counties on Monday, April 1.

The 8.8-mile mill and overlay will run north from K-68 to Shawnee Road, and then continue north from 6<sup>th</sup> Street in Wellsville to end at U.S. 56. Flaggers and a pilot car will guide one-lane traffic through the work zone; expect delays of 15 minutes or less. Weather permitting, the road work should be finished by mid-May.

KDOT awarded Bettis Asphalt & Construction, Inc., of Topeka the construction contract of \$1.3 million.
