## K-47 culvert survey begins this month

The week of Jan. 22 the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to begin a survey for a culvert replacement on K-47 in Crawford County. The culvert is 3½ miles east of the Neosho-Crawford county line.

The approximate length of the survey area is 2,000 feet. The survey is based on the existing highway alignment and is expected to be complete by March 15.

Activities include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor. A member of the survey crew will contact property owners or tenants for permission to enter private property. John Lilak of Bartlett and West will manage the survey for KDOT.
