## KDOT to replace bridge on U.S. 54 in Greenwood County

The week of March 4 the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) expects to start a project to replace the Homer Creek bridge on U.S. 54 in Greenwood County. The bridge is 4 miles east of the east K-99/U.S. 54 junction.

The bridge will be replaced one half at a time, with temporary signals controlling one-lane traffic at the work zone. Expect brief delays. The new bridge should be open in late 2024.

KDOT awarded the construction contract of \$3.8 million to Bridges Inc., of Newton.
