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K-31 resurfacing underway in Anderson and Coffey counties

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) has started a resurfacing project on K-31 in Anderson and Coffey counties. The 26-mile project area runs between the west city limits of Garnett and the north city limits of Waverly.

Project activity includes a scrub seal with a chip seal. The concrete pavement and brick crosswalks at Waverly will not be resurfaced. Flaggers and a pilot car are directing one-lane traffic through the work zone; expect delays of 15 minutes or less. Weather permitting, the road work should be finished by the end of August.

Vance Brothers Inc. and Subsidiary of Kansas City, Missouri, is the primary contractor on the \$1.6 million project.
