
## U.S. 59 to be resurfaced north of I-35

Monday, June 12, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) expects to start a resurfacing project on U.S. 59 in Franklin County. The 8-mile project runs from I-35 north to the Franklin-Douglas county line.

Activity includes a 3-inch overlay, 1-inch reflective crack interlayer, shoulder rumble strips and edge wedge. Traffic will be restricted to one lane in each direction with a speed limit of 55 miles per hour. Weather permitting, the road work should be finished this fall.

KDOT awarded the construction contract of \$15.2 million to Bettis Asphalt & Construction Inc., Topeka. Drivers are reminded to slow down and use extra caution in the work zone.
