## U.S. 75 section to close in June for culvert replacement

Starting Monday, June 5, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) will replace a culvert under U.S. 75 approximately 1½ miles south of the Altoona-Midway School in Wilson County. U.S. 75 will be closed to through traffic between K-47 and K-39. Traffic will be detoured on K-39, U.S. 400 and K-47 (see map). Weather permitting, the work should be finished and the highway reopened by Friday, June 9.
