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K-99 resurfacing project underway

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) has started work on a mill and overlay project on K-99 in Chautauqua County. The 6-mile project begins at the Oklahoma-Kansas border and continues north to U.S. 166.

Flaggers and a pilot car operation are guiding one-lane traffic through the work zone during daylight hours. Expect delays of 15 minutes or less. The road work should be completed by the end of June, weather permitting.

KDOT awarded the construction contract of \$1 million to Bettis Asphalt & Construction Inc., Topeka.
