K-99 resurfacing project begins in Greenwood County

The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) has started a scrub seal project on the 16¹/₂-mile section of K-99 between U.S. 400 and U.S. 54.

Flaggers and a pilot car will direct one-lane traffic through the work zone. Expect delays of 15 minutes or less during daylight hours until August.
