## Sidewalk improvement project to start in Gridley and Madison

Monday, March 27, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to begin a sidewalk improvement project in the communities of Gridley and Madison, weather permitting. Project activity includes the installation of ADA ramps, curb and gutter, signs and pavement markings. The contractor will work on one side of the road at a time, with no significant effects to traffic.

The sidewalk improvements in Gridley will be constructed at:

- K-58 and Main Street.
- K-58 and 1st Street.
- K-58 and South Street.

The improvements to be made at Madison:

- K-58 and 2<sup>nd</sup> Street.
- K-58 and 3<sup>rd</sup> Street.
- K-58 turn at 4<sup>th</sup> Street and Madison Avenue.

KDOT awarded the \$93,616 construction contract to Burlington Construction, Inc., of Burlington. The project should be completed by June.
