Railroad crossing repairs scheduled for U.S. 160 crossing in Plains

Union Pacific has announced plans to repair the U.S. 160 railroad crossing in Plains on Wednesday, March 28, weather permitting. The crossing will be closed during the repairs with a detour in place. Eastbound U.S. 160 traffic will be detoured to U.S. 83 south to U.S. 54 in Liberal and then east on U.S. 54 to Plains. Westbound traffic will be detoured west on U.S. 54 to Liberal and then north on U.S. 83 to U.S. 160.
