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Road work on K-4 begins in Ness County

Work has started on a resurfacing project on K-4 in Ness and Lane counties. The contractor is working from the east end of the project at the junction of K-4 and U.S. 283 in Ness County, west to the junction of K-4 and K-23 in Lane County.

During construction, traffic will be limited to one lane through the work zone, guided by a pilot car. Drivers can expect delays of 15 minutes or less. The Kansas DOT urges drivers to be alert, pay attention to all work zone warning signs, slow down when approaching a work zone and be prepared to stop.

Bettis Asphalt and Construction Inc., of Topeka, is the contractor on this approximately \$3.1 million preservation project. KDOT expects work on this project to be completed by mid-September, depending on weather.
