Roads closures continue in northwest Kansas

Winter weather conditions have caused the closure of several roads across northwest Kansas. Road closures as of 10 p.m. CST include:

- I-70 from WaKeeney to the Colorado border
- U.S. 36 from Oberlin to the Colorado border
- U.S. 40 from Oakley to the Colorado border
- U.S. 83 from Oberlin to the Nebraska border
- K-25 from U.S. 40 to the Nebraska border
- K-27 from Sharon Springs to the Nebraska border
- K-117 from U.S. 36 to the Nebraska border
- K-161 from U.S. 36 to the Nebraska border
