Road construction starting next week in Osborne

The Kansas Department of Transportation plans to begin roadwork on a portion of U.S. 281 (South 1st Street) in the city of Osborne starting the week of Aug. 17.

Crews will be replacing the concrete pavement, curb and gutter between Connecticut and Massachusetts streets. Traffic will be restricted to one lane through the work zone and controlled by a traffic signal. Minor delays not exceeding 5 minutes should be expected.

KDOT anticipates work to be completed by mid-November, weather permitting. The \$539,000 project is being funded through KDOT's City Connecting Link Improvement Program, which funds improvements to state highways that extend through cities.
