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Bridge repairs starting on I-70 in Russell County

The Kansas Department of Transportation plans to begin work on a pair of bridge repair projects along I-70 in Russell County the week of April 26.

Crews will be repairing the westbound bridges located between mile markers 196 and 200 near Dorrance. Traffic will be reduced to one lane through the construction zones with a decreased speed limit of 60 mph. Minor delays not exceeding 5 minutes should be anticipated. KDOT expects work to be completed by the end of July, weather permitting.

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Wildcat Construction Company is planning to start work on two bridge repairs in Russell County near Dorrance at the end of this month. The two bridges to be repaired are in the WB lanes of I-70, this work will require two phases, one for each WB lane. Traffic will be reduced to one WB lane during construction. The project is estimated to last for approx. 5 months. The contract is valued at \$428,899. Let me know if you need any additional information.
