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Chip seal project starting on K-27 in Sherman County

The Kansas Department of Transportation plans to begin a chip seal project on approximately 17 miles of K-27 in Sherman County the week of Aug. 30.

Project work will be from the Cheyenne County line south to the U.S. 24B junction in Goodland. Traffic will be reduced to one lane through the work zone and directed by flaggers and a pilot car. Motorists should expect possible delays of up to 15 minutes.

KDOT anticipates work to be completed in mid-September, weather permitting.
