Resurfacing project planned on K-25 in Thomas County

The Kansas Department of Transportation expects to begin work on a resurfacing project on a portion of K-25 in Thomas County the week of July 25.

Project work will involve a mill and overlay on 11.5 miles of K-25 starting near the north city limits in Colby and ending at the Rawlins County line. Traffic will be reduced to one lane through the work zone and directed by flaggers and a pilot car. Delays not exceeding 15 minutes should be anticipated.

KDOT expects work to be completed by the end of September, weather permitting.
