**K-383 reopened in Phillips County**

The Kansas Department of Transportation has reopened K-383 to traffic in Phillips County between Long Island and the U.S. 183 junction. The 6-mile section has been closed since March for reconstruction.

A final asphalt overlay on the road is planned for spring 2023.

The reconstruction is part of the T-WORKS project to reconstruct the 26-mile corridor between the east U.S. 36 junction in Norton County to U.S. 183 in Phillips County. Venture Corporation of Great Bend served as primary contractor for the \$11.8 million project.
