**U.S. 36 roadwork to start in Rawlins County**

The Kansas Department of Transportation plans to begin work on May 13 on a resurfacing project on a portion of U.S. 36 in Rawlins County.

The 16-mile project extends from 8<sup>th</sup> Street in Atwood east to the Decatur County line. Surface recycle work will begin on 8 miles of the project, from 8<sup>th</sup> Street to near County Road 29, followed by a chip seal on the full 16 miles. Traffic will be reduced to one lane and directed by flaggers and a pilot car. Delays up to 15 minutes may be possible. KDOT expects work to be completed by the end of June, weather permitting.
