K-177 to be closed Monday for bridge replacement

On Monday, August 3, the Kansas Department of Transportation will close K-177 near Strong City to replace the K-177 bridge over U.S. 50 in Chase County.

K-177 will remain closed throughout construction from Cottonwood Street to just north of U.S. 50, please follow the signed detour via U.S. 50 and Cottonwood Street in Strong City. (See attached map)

Bridges Inc. of Newton is the primary contractor for this \$2.8 million project. The contractor has scheduled work to be completed in January 2021, weather permitting.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a work zone. Check kandrive.org for updates and more information.
