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## Resurfacing on K-15 in Clay County begins today

On Thursday, July 23, the Kansas Department of Transportation will begin a mill and overlay with shoulder widening on K-15 in Clay County. Work on K-15 will occur between the north city limits of Clay Center and the Clay/Washington county line.

Construction will take place Monday through Friday with occasional Saturday work during daylight hours. Traffic will be reduced to one 12-foot lane following a pilot car through the work zone. Drivers should be prepared for a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

Hall Brothers Inc. of Marysville is the prime contractor and has scheduled this \$1.75 million project to be completed by October, weather permitting.
