U.S. 77 and K-18 interchange

Hamm Construction, Inc. has notified the Kansas Department of Transportation that the next phase of the U.S. 77/K-18 interchange project will begin on **Oct. 18**, weather permitting. This phase will require traffic changes as K-18 east of Spring Valley Road to U.S. 77 will be closed to all traffic.

There will be a signed detour for eastbound and westbound traffic on K-18. Eastbound will turn north on Spring Valley Road to Rucker Road, then east to U.S. 77. Westbound will travel U.S. 77 north to Rucker Road, then west to Spring Valley Road and south to K-18. This phase should be completed next Spring.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone.
