Rumble strip installation in Ellsworth & Geary counties

Rumble strips are being installed on K-156 from the junction of K-140/K-156 northeast 15 miles to the junction of K-156 and I-70 in Ellsworth County. And in Geary County on U.S. 77 from the junction of U.S. 77/I-70 north to Ash Street. These are slow-moving construction operations with traffic being controlled by flaggers. Drivers can expect a delay of less than five minutes.

The project is scheduled to be completed by Apr. 2, weather permitting. Surface Preparation Technologies LLC is the prime contractor.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone.
