Resurfacing project begins today on U.S. 81 in Cloud County

Beginning today, Monday, May 9, the Kansas Department of Transportation will resurface approximately five miles of U.S. 81 in Cloud County.

Work on U.S. 81 will begin at the Cloud/Ottawa County line and continue north to Eagle Road, about one mile north of the U.S. 24/U.S. 81 junction.

Traffic will be reduced to one lane at a reduced speed of 60 mph through the work zone. Drivers should expect minimal delays, not exceeding five minutes.

Hall Brothers Inc. of Marysville is the prime contractor for this \$2.5 million project which is scheduled for completion by August, weather permitting.

KDOT urges all motorists to be alert and obey the warning signs when approaching and driving through a highway work zone. To stay aware of all road construction projects across Kansas, go to www.kandrive.org or call 5-1-1.
