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Resurfacing project begins today on K-106 in Ottawa County

Beginning today, Monday, April 4, the Kansas Department of Transportation will resurface approximately 7.5 miles of K-106 in Ottawa County.

Work on K-106 will begin at the K-18/K-106 junction and continue north to the south city limits of Minneapolis.

Flaggers and a pilot car will direct one lane of traffic through construction. Drivers should be prepared for a delay of up to 15 minutes and plan extra time in their travel schedules.

Hall Brothers Inc. of Marysville is the prime contractor for this \$808,813 project which is scheduled for completion by May, weather permitting.
