Field survey starting for culvert extension in Chase County

Beginning Monday, Jan. 22, the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) plans to begin a field survey to gather information necessary for a proposed culvert extension on K-177 in Chase County.

The proposed improvements would be on K-177, about 12 miles north of the Chase/Butler County line. The length of the field survey will be about 2,000 feet, and the survey will be based on existing highway alignment.

Survey activities will include the use of survey instruments on the ground to determine locations of existing features within the corridor. A member of the survey crew will contact property owners or tenants for permission to enter private property.

KDOT expects this survey to be completed by March 15, 2024.
