All highways reopen in north central Kansas, travel still cautioned

Following the reopening of K-148 after the recent winter storm, all highways in north central Kansas have been reopened, according to the Kansas Department of Transportation.

Some highway closures were necessary due to drifting snow and dangerous winter weather. KDOT reminds motorists to drive with caution and give crews room to work as they continue to clear the roadways. Some roads are still snow packed or icy in areas.

Another chance of winter weather is expected early this week. Motorists are encouraged to stay up to date with road conditions and prepare for the incoming weather.
