Winter weather closes highways in north central Kansas

Because of low visibility and dangerous winter weather, the Kansas Department of Transportation has closed multiple highways in north central Kansas;

- Westbound I-70 closed from Salina to the Colorado border
- Eastbound I-70 closed from exit 205 in Ellsworth County to the Colorado border
- K-4 closed from north of Herrington to just south of Alta Vista
- K-149 closed from south of White City to U.S. 56

Motorists should anticipate more possible highway closings through the night in other counties across north central Kansas as road conditions continue to deteriorate due to heavy snowfall and high winds.
