Projects that promote safety, improve access or mobility and update transportation technology can receive financial assistance in the Kansas Department of Transportation's Innovative Technology Program.

"The Innovative Technology Program is a great opportunity to assist rural and urban areas with funding to move forward with their innovative ideas to improve their day-to-day governmental responsibilities through the use of technology and data," said KDOT Innovative Technologies Director Mike Floberg.

The program has \$2 million available this fiscal year. A minimum of 25% non-state cash match is required, and additional consideration will be given to applications that contribute more.
