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Bridge Repairs on I-70 in Saline County

Bridge carrying traffic over I-70 at the Brookville Interchange (238) began Monday, July 15th, 2013. The project involves reshaping the berms under the I-70 bridges and resurfacing the roadway over the bridge between the ramp terminals. Traffic on the cross road (Brookville Rd.) is restricted to one lane and is controlled by traffic signals. Plans call for the project to be completed by mid-September weather permitting.

The purpose of the project is to extend the life of the bridge while improving ride quality.

APAC Inc. Shears Division, Salina, is the prime contractor. Project cost is \$124,950.00.
