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Chip Seal Begins on K-15 in Dickinson County

A KDOT project is scheduled to begin Wednesday, July 31, 2013, on K-15 in Dickinson County. Plans call for a chip seal to be applied to the highway's surface beginning at the Dickinson/Marion County line then north to the south city limit of Abilene. The project then picks-up at the north city limit and continue north to the west K-15/K-18 junction.

Traffic within the work zone will be controlled by flaggers and a pilot car carrying traffic thru the work zone at a reduced speed. The work zone shall be in effect during daylight hours only. Drivers need to pay close attention and be prepared to stop.

The purpose of this project is to extend the life of the highway and improve ride quality.

Mid-America Road Builders Inc. of Platte City, MO. is the prime contractor for this project. Project cost is \$1,059,450.00.
