I-70 Construction in Ellsworth County

Beginning Tuesday, May 14th a slow moving work zone will begin on I-70 in Ellsworth County. The work area starts at mile marker 205 (the Russell/Ellsworth County line) then moves east ending at the I-70/I-135/US-81 Interchange near Salina. Within the work zone traffic will be reduced to one lane for the instillation of rumble strips and pavement markings.

Plans call for the project to be completed in mid-July, 2013, weather permitting.
