K-43 traffic Detoured South of Enterprise

A portion of K-43 in Dickinson County will be closed to traffic Thursday, Oct 11th. Beginning around 8 am K-43 from 1800 Ave to 1400 Ave will be closed to traffic. All southbound traffic on K-43 out of Enterprise will be detoured onto 1800 Ave then west 3 miles to Jeep Rd then south to 1400 Ave then east to rejoin K-43. Northbound traffic will take this detour in reverse.

The purpose of the closure is to remove the temporary surface material and replace it with an asphalt overlay. The temporary surface was put in place to allow traffic to access the road while the earth covering the new culvert below could settle and compact.

Plans call for the roadwork to be completed and K-43 reopened to traffic at or around 5 pm the same day weather permitting.
