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## Road work around Garden City moves to US-50

The series of resurfacing projects on highways in and around Garden City moves to U.S. 50 on Monday, August 19, with a mill and overlay project from the intersection of U.S. 50 Business (Fulton Street) and Campus Drive, east to the intersection of U.S. 50 and Towns Road, a distance of about three miles.

Drivers should expect single lane closures on this four-lane road and traffic will be carried through construction. The Kansas DOT urges drivers to be alert, pay attention to all work zone warning signs, slow down when approaching a work zone and be prepared to stop.

KDOT expects this project to be completed by late September, depending on weather. APAC Kansas, Inc., Shears Division is the primary contractor on this project with a contract cost of approximately \$1.1 million.
